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The route is approximately $11 / 2$ miles long and takes $1-1 \frac{1}{2}$ hours to complete. The only steps are on the Promenade and can be avoided so it is suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs although there are steep hills in places.

Parking can be found along Glebe Road.
Start outside the tourist information on the junction of Glebe Road and Promenade.
All clues are visible without intruding on private areas such as gardens etc.
