

The route is approximately 1¹/₂ miles long and takes 1-1¹/₂ hours to complete. The only steps are on the Promenade and can be avoided so it is suitable for pushchairs and wheelchairs although there are steep hills in places.

Parking can be found along Glebe Road.

Start outside the tourist information on the junction of Glebe Road and Promenade.

All clues are visible without intruding on private areas such as gardens etc.

There is no hidden treasure (that we know of), simply answer the questions and collect the items listed on the next page to get points and the team with the most points wins. Have fun.
